## Canon Rebel

A dual-purpose HD video/photo camera, this dSLR camera delivers excellent video and image quality, has interchangeable lenses, can use a pop-up or external flash, and includes a number of user-defined controls. Uses an SD card for memory.

## Lytro Field Camera

Allows composition of pictures in a multi-dimensional way that can be refocused *afterward*, providing multiple focal points for a single image. The possibilities for compelling, "living" pictures are vast. (Uses internal memory only.)

## Canon Powershot

A point-and-shoot camera that captures photos and videos with ease, with a 12x optical zoom, fast auto-focus, flash, and a quick preset dial to ensure image quality. Uses an SD card for memory.
